### TWO MAIN PROBLEMS

Clinicians get consent from the families for autopsy\*, but they are not the ones performing the procedure
 \*know the rules at your institution

 Patients often talk to their nurses more than they talk to their doctors, but nurses also don't know about autopsy

### MOST COMMON MISCONCEPTIONS

#### Cost

- Misconception autopsy cost is billed to family
- Truth autopsy is FREE to family\* \*always know the rules at your institution

#### Incisions

- Misconception an open casket funeral cannot be performed after autopsy
- Truth none of the incisions made at autopsy, including the head incision, can be seen when the body is clothed; an open casket funeral can be held normally

## HOW WE'VE ADDRESSED THESE PROBLEMS

- Lectures, grand rounds, etc to various clinician groups about autopsy
  - Cost
  - Incisions
  - Timing
  - What information can be obtained
